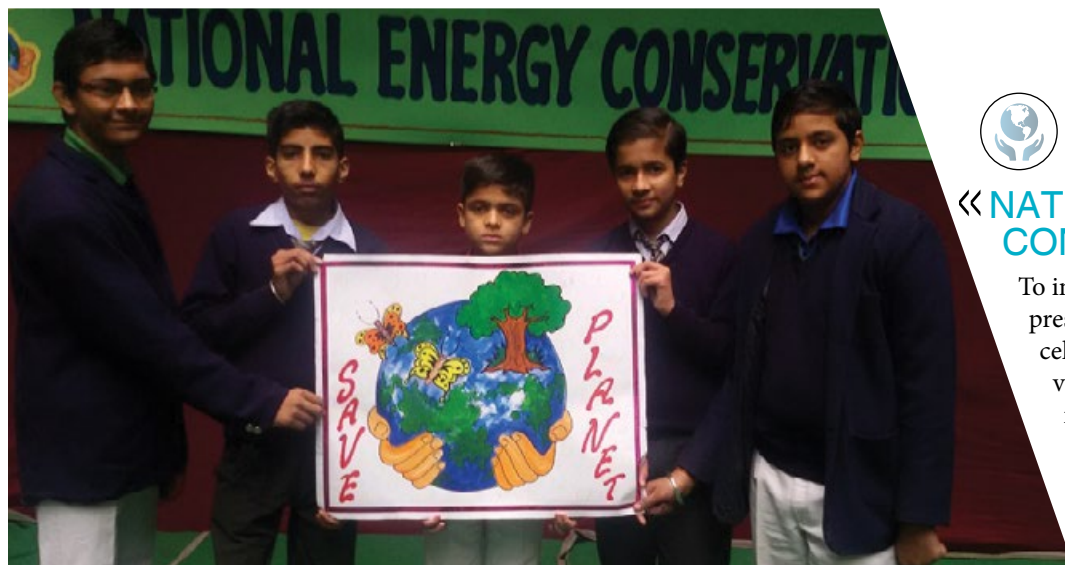
### UTSAV

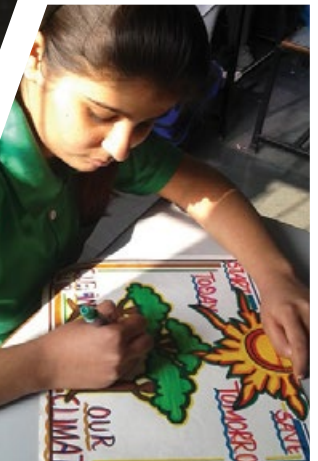
**ANNUAL SPORTS MEET** »
