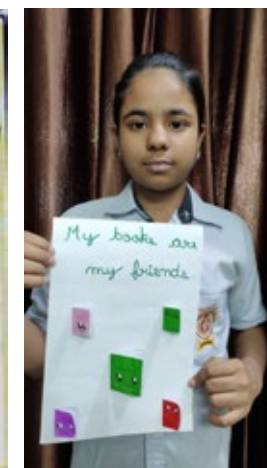
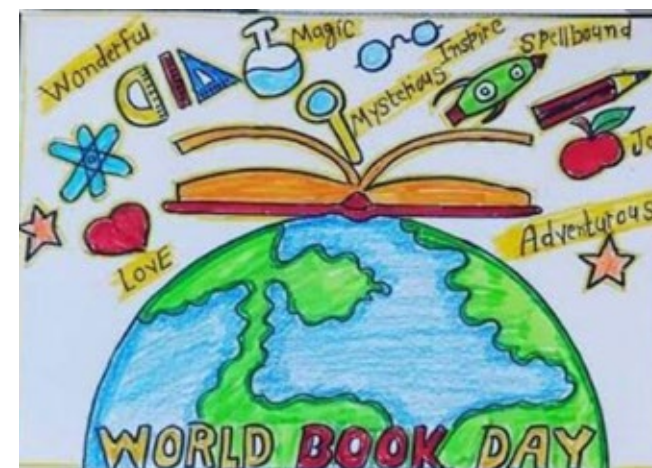
## WORLD HEALTH DAY
